working together for warm homes

- London Warm Zone is a not for profit arm of the charity National Energy Action (NEA).
- London Warm Zones main funder is EDF Energy.
- London Warm Zone works with 14 London Boroughs on sub-regional decent homes programmes 2006-2008 budget in excess of £10 million all to vulnerable homes.

- Warm Zone originally created as a Fuel Poverty programme in 2001.
- Today a fully holistic private sector housing project delivery organisation. Work ranging from Decent Homes, Renewable technologies to Local Area Agreements Programmes (LAA'S) and Academic Research.
- Warm Zones main programmes are Sub -Regional Central Heating and Benefits uptake services meaning Fuel Poverty is still very much a major output of Warm Zones work.

warm zone Output 2006 - 2008

- Assessments 60,000
- Sub-Regional Heating Systems 3000 (Non decent system replacement)
- EEC Insulation Measures 10,000
- Warm Front Surveys 3000 (12% heating works if system is broken or intermittently working)
- £1 million in increased Benefits uptake

warm zone Developments

- Free Solar Water Heating as part of sub-regional Decent Home Package for Vulnerable homes designed by Yale University. Pilot started In London Borough of Harrow Feb 2007
- Provision of Warm Zone Assessment and Benefits service to other Organisations and Sub-Regions from DEFRA Funding.
- Fire Safety and HHSRS surveys.
